Dear parent/carers

We have been made aware that many of our Year 8 students are using apps such as Tiktok, Snapchat and WhatsApp to communicate with peers outside of school. While most of the time these are positive interactions, we are aware that there has been an increase in students using social media inappropriately.

Considering the issues that have been brought into school, we politely ask all parents/carers to closely monitor their child's use of these apps. There have been instances where second accounts have been created so parents are not able to see the online activity.

We recommend that:

- You check your child's phone and online use weekly and talk about anything that you/your child may be concerned about
- If your child receives an unpleasant message/post, block, report and delete the contact/number who sent it (even if this person used to be a friend)
- limit screentime to the national recommendation of 2 hours per day and avoid screentime an hour before bed as not to disrupt healthy sleep patterns
- ensure your child does not share personal information such as their phone number or address in their bio
- do not accept friend requests from people they don't personally know
- create or be part of large groups/sharing platforms such as TikTok live

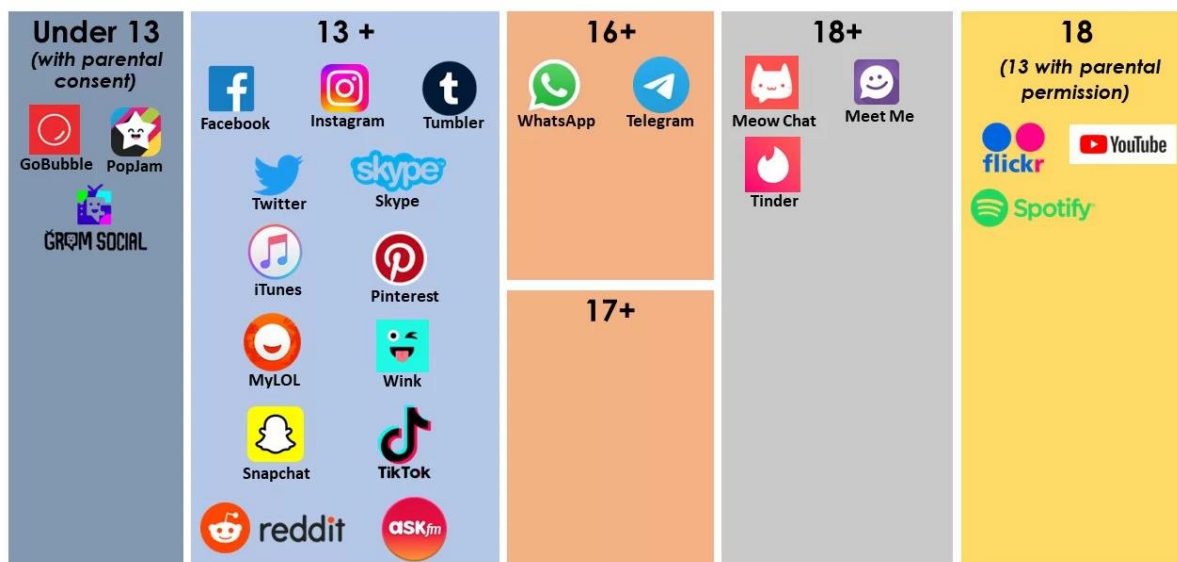
